We did not hold an annual meeting in 2020 because of the pandemic and we had not yet fully adopted Zoom. This year, on May 19, we held a Member Information meeting on Zoom in lieu of an in-person Annual General Meeting. About 40 members participated, as the board reviewed the contents of our Annual Report and solicited comments and feedback on the year, particularly about our use of Zoom for our classes. While most who attended were quite favorable towards Zoom classes, there is also widespread appreciation of the benefits of in-person classes. We were able to assure members that, while this coming Fall '21 semester will also be on Zoom, our plan for Spring '22 is to have as many classes in-person as we can, with some Zoom classes as well.

One other item of note is that, at our May 25 meeting, the Board of Directors voted to extend each board member's and officer's term by one year because we were not able to conduct an election this past year. We will do what we can to identify a Nominating Committee and Chair while still in all-Zoom mode this fall, but I expect that most of the effort will need to wait until we are back in person in the Spring. Meanwhile, we would very much like to hear from members who would like to participate in the nomination process.
